





# NOTICE OF RACE Open Dutch Masters Championship ILCA 7 & 6 class Regatta ILCA 4 class

organized by WV Braassemermeer under the auspices of the RNWA from 29<sup>th</sup> of May to 1<sup>st</sup> of June (inclusive) 2025 location: Braassemermeer, Roelofarendsveen

The notation '[NP]' in a rule means that a boat may not protest another boat for breaking that rule. This changes RRS 60.1(a).

### 1 RULES

- 1.1 The event is governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS)*. The Prescriptions of the RNWA can be found at https://www.sailing.org/inside-world-sailing/rules-regulations/racingrules
- 1.2 The 'Rules for (Open) Championships Sailing, Windsurfing and Kiteboarding' (available at reglement-voor-kampioenschappen-20191101-v5-docx.pdf (watersportverbond.nl) will apply.
- 1.3 RRS 90.3 (e) applies with a time limit of 48 hours. This changes RRS 90.3e.
- 1.4 Sails shall have the full sail number AND NATIONAL LETTERS in accordance with the Class Rules and RRS. The national letters shall denote the National Authority of which the sailor is a member in accordance with RRS 75. This changes RRS Appendix G1.1.
- 1.5 If there is a conflict between languages the text in the English language will take precedence.
- 1.6 Every person on board who has his domicile in the Netherlands shall have the appropriate license.

- 1.8 RRS Appendix P applies.
- 1.9 RRS Appendix T, Arbitration applies.

### 3 COMMUNICATION

3.1 Notices to competitors will be posted on the official notice board at the yachtclub WV Braassemermeer, on the first floor of the clubhouse.







3.2 [DP] From the first warning signal until the end of the last race of the day, except in an emergency, a boat shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communication that is not available to all boats.

### 4 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 4.1 The event is open to all boats of the ILCA class(es).
- 4.2 If you're not sure which Masters category you fall into, please refer to the table below. You shall reach the following ages during 2025 but should be 30 at the time of the first race of the event.

- 4.3 Eligible boats may enter before 23rd of May 23:59 hours at the following website: <a href="https://www.lasermasters.nl">www.lasermasters.nl</a> (Dutch Open ILCA Masters, entry form).
- The required fee shall be transferred to the following bank account on the name of E.C.Sierhuis: IBAN NL91 RABO 0109.1490.25. Please state class and sail number.
- 4.5 To be considered an entry in the event, a boat shall complete all registration requirements and pay all fees.
- 4.6 The following restrictions on the number of boats apply:

  If for the ILCA 7 class the number of 60 entries is reached the entry shall be closed for the ILCA 7 class.

If for the ILCA 6 and 4 class together the number of 60 entries is reached the entry shall be closed for the ILCA 6 and 4 class.

### 5 FEES

- 5.1 Entry fees are as follows: All classes: € 140,-

### 6 CREW LIMITATIONS

6.1 ILCA class rule 7 (a) is restricted as follows: "Only one person shall be on board whilst racing.

The person shall be named on the entry form."

- 15.1 Four races are required to be completed to constitute a championship.
  - (a) When fewer than 5 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.
  - (b) When 5, 6, 7 or 8 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.
  - (c) When 9 or 10 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her two worst scores.

### 21 RISK STATEMENT

- 21.1 RRS 3 states: 'The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue to race is hers alone.' By participating in this event each competitor agrees and acknowledges that sailing is a potentially dangerous activity with inherent risks. These risks include strong winds and rough seas, sudden changes in weather, failure of equipment, boat handling errors, poor seamanship by other boats, loss of balance on an unstable platform and fatigue resulting in increased risk of injury. Inherent in the sport of sailing is the risk of permanent, catastrophic injury or death by drowning, trauma, hypothermia or other causes.
- 21.2 The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

### 22 INSURANCE

22.1 Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of Euro 1.500.000 or the equivalent per incident.

### 23 PRIZES

- 23.1 The RNWA supplies for the winning boat (ILCA 7 & 6 fleet) a blue pennant and a medal for every member of the crew of the first three boats
- Other prizes will be given as follows based on the number of entries per "Age group" registered on Saturday 1st May 2025:

Up to 5 competitors	1 prize
6 to 10 competitors	2 prizes
11 + competitors	3 prizes

For women will be 3 prizes.

23.3 The minimum number of competitors per category is 3. In case of less competitors, the competitor(s) will compete in the next available category.


- 3. Parking cars, boats, trailers and ribs: See www.lasermasters.nl
